

Eagle Scout Rank Application

The Eagle process is an exercise in skills each Eagle Scout candidate should have acquired through school and Scouts. It is an exercise in planning and presenting. Legibility is paramount.

A pre-filled Eagle Scout Rank Application can be found for any Scouts BSA youth member through Scoutbook, just type references and print:



If any merit badges are missing from the application, that means they are not properly recorded on the Scout's advancement record.

The blank form can be found in Advancement Resources linked above.

Eagle Scout Recommendations are now needed from four references (still ask 5-7 references). References can no longer include parent/guardian, Scoutmaster or Troop Committee Chair (2025 GtA).
